

REGULAR TOWN BOARD MEETING
MAY 16, 2022

Motion to open meeting at 6:30 pm was made by Nicholas Lansing and seconded by Cynthia Durant. All in favor were Howard Goodrow and Chad Rivers.

Pledge said.

Chad talked about the new wall on the side of the American Legion and commended the guys for all of the hours and hard work that they put in over there last weekend. Don asked Cindy to check the light at night over there to see if it's on.

Motion to approve the minutes of the April board meeting as written was made by Howard Goodrow and seconded by Nicholas Lansing. All in favor were Cynthia Durant and Chad Rivers.

Motion to accept the minutes of the Special board meeting as written was made by Cynthia Durant and seconded by Howard Goodrow. All in favor were Nicholas Lansing and Chad Rivers.

Supervisor's Report:

Bills: Chad asked the board to wait until next week to come in and sign the bills and if they have already done so to please come back next Tuesday. He is expecting more bills to come in on Monday and would like to pay them on Wednesday so if they could come in on Tuesday that would be great.

Cindy said that there was a bill from Power Line Industries that had no invoice.

Trash Service Closing: Chad said that they have issued \$94.00 in refunds so far.

Assessor Re-Val Update: Chad said that Dave isn't prepared at this time and will get everything in order for the June meeting. Chad said that he spoke to Cory and Bruce and they both said that they are still interested in doing the data collecting. Grievance Day is set for May 31st. Donna will not be in attendance that day as she will be having a procedure. They will need to find someone to replace her.

Town Mowing: Chad said that the cleanup is all done and they have already done their first round of mowing. He spoke to them about some of the weed whacking and they will take care of it. He also told them that they have to keep all of the garbage cleaned up. Cindy asked if cemetery is all done and Chad said yes and that it looks really good.

Campsite: Chad explained that they are open for business. He and John rebuilt the deck surface and railing on the cabin. They spent 2 days doing that and Chad is very happy about the way it turned out. Chad said that they are going to replace the railing at the A-Frame. He and John walked the premises and everything that they were supposed to do from the list they had from last year has been taken care of. Chad said that we need to buy a couple of weed whackers this year. Also the picnic tables are in bad disarray. As soon as the grant money comes in they plan on building 20 new picnic tables. Cindy asked how the reservations were going and Chad said they are normal at this point. They did have a couple of cancelations due to COVID.

Chad said that we need to advertise for the Summer Youth work again. He said that we also need a couple more lifeguards as we have a couple that aren't coming back this year. Charity, Alexis and Calista will all be back.

WATER/SEWER: Jeff came in today and said that he has taken the last course that he needed to become a 2A operator. He now has to take the State test then he will be the same operator as Chris is.

Cindy asked about the water break and Chad explained that they are still waiting on parts. He said that it's in an area where they did a band aid fix on it before and they want to do a full repair this time. As soon as the parts come in they will tackle it.

Highway Update: They completed the paving on the Wait Road today and will do some on the South River Road tomorrow. They had intentions of paving the upper and lower road at the campsite but have since found out that DOT says that those two roads are not considered town roads. Therefore we cannot receive any CHIPS

money for these roads.

Cindy asked if they are only doing the Wait Road and South River Road and Chad said that he thought they were going to do some of the Walker Road too but it doesn't look that way.

Cindy said that she hasn't seen a bill from the Accountants yet. Chad explained that we did pay last years but they haven't sent one yet this year.

Cindy asked if anyone has looked at the roof at the Fire Station yet and Chad said no but he will try to do that.

Public Comments:

Lawrence asked about the old Mayville place. He said it's a mess there and was wondering if anyone was living there. Chad said that he has had several complaints regarding this place. He said that he will talk to Bruce regarding it.

Lawrence asked if when we get the grant money, will we use some to tear down the bridge and Chad said yes. He would still like to work on some grant money to one day replace the bridge.

Randy Morris said that they will be having a dedication for the new wall around noon on Memorial Day following the parade and cemeteries. They will also be having hot dogs and etc.

Motion to close meeting at 7:10 pm was made by Nicholas Lansing and seconded by Cynthia Durant. All in favor were Howard Goodrow and Chad Rivers.
